

2022-23 Community Support Levy Grants Round

Funded Projects

The 2022-23 Community Support Levy Grants Round provided funding of \$391,025 (ex-GST) for 14 community projects.

The Community Support Levy (CSL) is drawn from the profits of electronic gaming machines (pokies) in hotels and clubs. Part of the CSL is distributed back into the community through the CSL Grants Program which provides grassroots community organisations with opportunities to access funding for equipment or projects which will benefit vulnerable groups.

The theme of the 2022-23 CSL Grants Round was preventing and reducing gambling harms. Applications were sought for projects that addressed preventing gambling harm; reducing gambling harm; and social, environmental and/or health issues associated with gambling.

Three categories of funding were available:

- Innovation Project grants of up to \$100,000 (ex-GST) to undertake significant projects exploring innovative approaches to the prevention and reduction of harm from gambling.
- Community Project grants of up to \$30,000 (ex-GST) to deliver projects that enhance the wellbeing of vulnerable individuals, families and communities.
- Small Equipment grants of up to \$5,000 (ex-GST) to enable organisations to add value to their community services through the purchase of equipment such as furniture, IT equipment and tools.

Funded Projects

The 2022-23 CSL Grants Round funded 14 projects for a total of \$391,025 (ex-GST).

Projects funded included:

- Three Innovation Project grants for \$256,216
- Four Community Project grants for \$105,000
- Seven Small Equipment grants for \$29,809.
